Directions

From I-787 Southbound

I-787 South to Clinton Avenue exit 4B. At bottom of exit ramp take a left onto Broadway, Continue down Broadway 3 traffic lights. At light take a right onto State Street. Jack's will be on your left.

From I-787 Northbound

I-787 North (from Thruway Exit 23) to Exit 4 - "Route 9 North." You will be on a one way access road between the elevated highway and the river. Proceed to the Clinton Avenue exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp, take a left onto Broadway. State Street is 3 traffic lights up on your right. Take a right onto State Street and Jacks will be on your immediate left.

From I-90 East or West

Take I-90 towards Albany to Exit 7 (I-787 South.) Follow directions above for I-787 Southbound

PARKING is free on-street after 6 PM. Valet parking is also available for \$5.00 per car.
