### **Outstanding Patron Service Skills and Colleague Interaction**

Alert to patron needs; possesses excellent communication skills

### **Responsibility**

Demonstrates professionalism and high standards of performance

### **Strong Leadership among Peers**

Sets a good example for other student workers; models professional demeanor

### **Interest and Initiative**

Looks for projects and expresses interest in learning about the library profession
