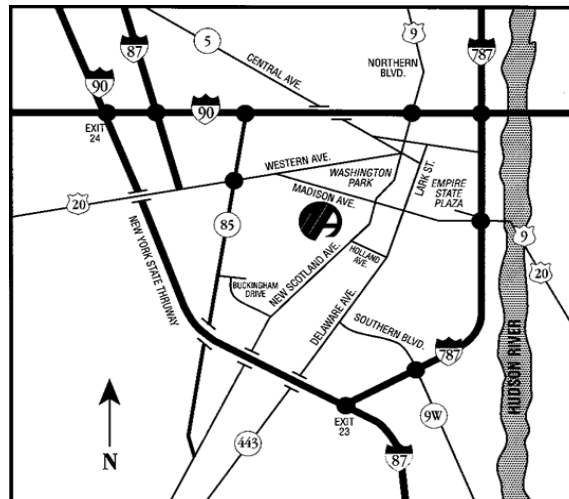

**Directions:**

Take the Northway (I-87) to I-90 East. Exit at I-787 South (Albany). Exit at Madison Avenue. Proceed approximately one mile on Madison Avenue. Turn left onto New Scotland Avenue. Go two blocks. Albany Medical Center will be on your right. Parking is either on street or in the paid lots.

Enter through the Neil Hellman building College front entrance, then:

- Turn right and walk to the library.
- Enter the library and turn left at the desk.
- Take Elevators to the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor.
- Go straight to 2<sup>nd</sup> door on right for the computer lab.
